Forty is a significant number; especially if you're in your late thirties. It marks "mid-life" and is a wakeup call to "count the number of our days," so that we live them to the full. In the Scriptures, forty is often associated with significant events in the life of God's people.

When the LORD determined to flood the earth in judgment for mankind's sinfulness, He caused it to rain for **forty days and nights**. **At day 40**, Noah opened a window in the ark and sent out a raven, to determine if the water had begun to recede. **At age 40**, Isaac was married to Rebekah. When Moses went up on Mount Sinai to receive God's Law, he was there for **40 days and nights**, without food or water – sustained by the LORD.

When Moses sent spies to explore the Promised Land, they took **40 days** to gather information. When the majority yielded to unbelief because of the giants they found in the land, the LORD determined they would wander in the wilderness **1 year for each of those 40 days**. But He also provided for His people in the wilderness, **supplying manna** (bread from heaven) and **supernaturally protecting their clothing** so that it did not wear out during those **40 years**. Fast forward to the New Testament. Immediately after being baptized by John in the River Jordan (and filled with the Spirit), **Jesus' spent 40 days in the wilderness** being tempted by Satan. Those days helped to form his initiation into full-time ministry.

Fast forward again, to the end of Jesus' life and earthly ministry. Christ died on the Friday, just before the Sabbath began— after celebrating the Passover with His disciples the night before. He victoriously arose from the grave, first thing Sunday morning. The Risen Christ then appeared to His disciples throughout Resurrection Sunday — to Mary Magdelene in the garden, to Peter, and to the two disciples walking along the Emmaus road. He then appeared to the Eleven (minus Thomas), as they met secretly behind closed doors that Sunday night.



The Gospel's careful recording of Jesus resurrection appearances, are vital to our faith. If Christ did not rise from the dead, Paul says, then we are still dead in our sins; our faith is useless and so is my preaching. More than that, we're guilty of lying, if God did not raise Christ from the grave. And those who have died "in Christ" are eternally lost – if Jesus is still dead and buried (1 Corinthians 15:14-19).

But Christ has indeed been resurrected back to life. He lives! Starting on Resurrection Sunday and for the next 40 days, Jesus appeared to His apostles in various circumstances (Acts 1:3). His purpose was to give them irrefutable proof that He had triumphed over death. In 1 Corinthians 15, Paul testifies that the Risen Christ appeared to the Twelve in the Upper Room (not once, but twice) and to five hundred people at one time. Later, Jesus personally confronted Paul on the road to Damascus. Forty days of compelling hands-on experiences in which they saw, heard and touched the Risen Savior –forging within them rock-solid faith & fortitude, to faithfully bear witness to a hostile

world that Christ is risen.

Friends, it would be easy to step off the mountaintop we call Easter, and return to "life as normal." But the Bible challenges us. The Risen Christ invites you and I to not only join Him in His death, burial and resurrection, but to boldly pray for the fullness of His Spirit, so that we might be fearless witnesses to our Lord & Savior, Jesus Christ.

Would you join me, in asking God to grant us Holy Spirit boldness in testifying to Jesus? Ask God for divine appointments in people's lives where we can introduce them to Jesus. In these next 40 days, may we work and pray for a spiritual harvest... "This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples." (John 15:8).

On the Alliance Giving Page, you will have 4 different online giving options:

- **#1** You may give an undesignated gift to the **Great Commission Fund (GCF).** This covers the IW's compensation, travel, and basic ministry & operating budgets. Undesignated giving is crucial for the Alliance to launch new initiatives and to support our 700+ IWs as they reach the unreached.
- **#2** You may give to **A Worker You Love** this giving is applied directly to the IW that you've identified. It provides a portion of their compensation and allows the IW to direct funds toward strategic ministry needs or other projects they are doing to create access to the Gospel.
- #3 You may give directly to A Project You Love this is aimed at supporting a specific project that has been approved by the Alliance leadership team where your IW serves.
- **#4** You may also give to **Relief & Development (CAMA Services)** this giving helps the most vulnerable in our world to recover from disasters, or it assists needy people in some of the world's most challenging places, to build a sustainable lifestyle.

#### PROJECT REIMAGINE UPDATE

**Project Reimagine** is the name of the Alliance National Office's capital campaign, that is focused on building a new debt-free campus in Reynoldsville, OH. As of January 2024, the first 11,000 square feet has been fully funded at \$400/square foot. There's 54,000 square feet left to go. That sounds like a lot, and it is – but remember we are one of almost 2000 Alliance churches. If each church does its part, the financial goals are doable. **So far, we have received \$2600** in giving toward Project Reimagine (ie, we "own" 8 ½ sf). **Our goal is to see every FAC giving unit contribute \$400** toward this project, by the end of 2024.

#### **Recent Governing Board News**

The search for an Assistant Pastor for Next Generation/Worship continues. We would ask that you make this a prayer priority this month. We want to see God direct us to the person of His choosing. Pray with the faith of Abraham – "who believed God" and acted on his faith. In the meantime, the Board continues to talk about and weigh the cost of what it takes to effectively reach the Next Generations of the not-yet believers. Jesus taught that new wine only works well when it's place in new wineskins. May we be willing to "pay the price" needed, to serve younger adults and families.

Pastor Adriaan is helping the Board to explore some fresh new ways of approaching our Discipleship ministries over the summer months. Stay tuned for more info on that.

The Board has been working with the Safety Team to update our vetting process, application forms and Safety Team Handbook. We are grateful for Bruce's leadership in this area, and all those who volunteer to serve as the FAC Safety Team.

In order to leverage the LORD's resources for maximum return, the Board has established a saving account with Orchard Alliance, that pays higher interest than we can get through our local bank. We now have just over \$20,000 in General Reserve & Life Conference funds parked in this account. We also have a \$15,234 CD of General Fund reserves with Orchard. We praise God for His kindness in providing such generous giving each month!
