Many in our church family would describe the last year (2023) as being a rough one. We experienced so many deaths and the heartache of grief, over and over again. But we also saw new life being birthed amongst us – as 6 children and adults put their trust in the LORD, and the Reifke's welcomed their first child (shortly after moving to Idaho).

Yes, we saw people we love, moving on to other places and some to other churches. Average attendance dipped to 102 in-person on Sundays, with another 49 watching online. But we also welcomed a number of new people to FAC, and we're richer for it. Our Griefshare support group not only brought hope to hurting hearts, but the gift of new friendships. As one person put it, "I told my family I've got two sisters now that I didn't have before!" We look forward to seeing those relationships grow even deeper in 2024.

It was hard seeing Kaleb & Katlyn leave FAC early in the Fall, and watching others choose to depart at the same time. But then the LORD brought some new people into our fellowship. We began the search for a new Next Gen/Worship Pastor, as the job description was posted online. In the meantime, we have been praying hard and anticipating God's timing, to direct us to the person He has been preparing for FAC. God is going to do even MORE in '24!

One of the joys last year, was watching God supply superabundantly throughout 2023. We ended the year at 103% of budget, and broke \$300,000 in General Fund giving. We have been blessed by generous "above & beyond" giving that allowed us to pay off the construction loan with Orchard Alliance, in less than a year. On top of that, we had strong giving to Alliance missions, and sent a 5 person team to Senegal in February. I had the privilege of going back to Africa in November, to lead a prayer retreat for some Alliance IWs. It will be fun to see how God chooses to work thru His people as we plan to send another team to Senegal and visit the other IW team in Africa by year-end. There's going to be a lot MORE in '24!

Marketers are savvy people – they know now is the time to promote new diets, gym memberships and sales on exercise equipment. Well, the Scripture says that kind of training is beneficial, but training in godliness is even more crucial (1 Timothy 4:8). That is why I encourage us **sign up for the Alliance 40 Days of Prayer** (https://40days.cmalliance.org/subscribe). Let's determine to be people of the Word and of prayer – even MORE in '24!! The Bible testifies that "they devoted themselves to the apostle's teaching... and to prayer" – Acts 2:42.

#### **GIVING TO ALLIANCE MISSIONS IN 2024**

There are 5 different ways to financially support Alliance missions. You can always write a check to FAC, and designate your gift on the memo line for the Great Commission Fund (GCF) or to a specific IW (by name). To give online, go to this link: <a href="https://secure.cmalliance.org/give/">https://secure.cmalliance.org/give/</a>

Through that online link, you will be given at least 4 giving options:

You may give an undesignated gift to the **Great Commission Fund (GCF).** This covers the IW's compensation, travel, and basic ministry & operating budgets. Generous undesignated giving is crucial for the Alliance to launch new initiatives to reach the unreached.

You may give to **A Worker You Love** – this giving is applied directly to the IW that you've identified. It provides a portion of their compensation and allows the IW to direct funds toward strategic ministry needs or other things they are doing to create access to the Gospel.

You may give to **A Project You Love** – this giving is aimed at a specific project that has been approved by the Alliance leadership team where your IW serves.

You may also give to **Relief & Development (CAMA Services)** – this giving is used to help the most vulnerable in our world, to recover from disasters and to assist people to build a sustainable lifestyle the world's most challenging places.

#### **Governing Board News**

The Board met in early December, and looked at a number of year-end financial matters. A special gift of \$500 was sent to the SHACK ministry in Greybull, WY – as a show of support for Jen Patrick, who is now the new Executive Director. The Board also approved a new copier lease, that will save us some money on monthly lease fees, starting in 2024.

Our Treasurer, Mark Eckles, reported on the establishment of a High Interest Savings Account. The Board approved moving up to \$18,000 in reserve cash funds, into this account, to maximize interest earnings in 2024. The Board reviewed the Active Members roll, and made adjustments based on Elder recommendations. Del Hayter and Sheryl Shockley were appointed to serve as the Board representatives on the 2024 Nominating Committee. Del was given the go ahead to contract with LG Electric on getting the basement fluorescent light fixtures converted to LED.
