over a French army, with parades, folk music and dancing. On the 12th, our country will celebrate all those who are moms and grandmothers, for their priceless investment in our families. While there is great joy associated with Mother's Day, it can also a very painful day for those who've suffered at the hands of their mothers. Others who longed to become moms, but couldn't, wrestle with their lost dream. Mother's Day is a mixed bag of conflicted emotions in the midst of bouquets & the flowery words.

On May 27th, America will remember her men and women who've paid the ultimate price to protect our freedoms. Memorial Day weekend will be filled with festivities, picnics and BBQs, along with ceremonies honoring those who sacrificed their lives to defend our rights, preserving the pledge to provide liberty and justice for all.



But tucked in the middle of May (the 19th to be exact), is a day that only appears on church calendars. Pentecost Sunday marks 50 days after the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the grave. According to Acts 1, during the first forty days, the Risen Christ appeared to His disciples at different times and places, offering them convincing proof that He had indeed risen from the dead.

Ten days before Pentecost, Jesus gave His followers some final instructions, urging them to wait for power from God to be poured out upon them Then He ascended into heaven (Acts 1:9). For days, they cried out to God, "asking, seeking and knocking" thru persistent prayer, for God to do all He had promised. On Pentecost (the Jewish harvest festival), the Holy Spirit was suddenly poured out upon the disciples. The manifest presence of God was experienced as Jesus' Church came to life.

The church does a great job remembering the Risen Christ at Easter, but we often fail to recognize the importance of Christ's ascension. Jesus had to go, so that the Holy Spirit could come (John 16:7). It is only through the empowering of the Holy Spirit, that our Gospel witness becomes effective. We need the power of the Spirit, to finish the Great Commission.

As we anticipate Pentecost Sunday, may we pray earnestly for a further infilling of the Spirit, to empower us to do our part in taking Jesus to a lost and dying world.

GIVING TO ALLIANCE MISSIONS

Did you know that it takes 70% undesignated giving to <u>the GCF</u> and 30% designated giving to a specific <u>International Worker or Project</u> to support over 700 Alliance IWs around the world?

Here's how you can give to Alliance missions: The easiest way is to write a check to FAC, and write GCF (Great Commission Fund) or the name of a specific IW on the memo line.

Or, you can go to: <u>https://secure.cmalliance.org/give/</u> where you will find 4 online giving options...

#1 - You may give directly to the **Great Commission Fund (GCF).** This covers the IW's compensation, travel, and basic ministry & operating budgets. This kind of undesignated giving is crucial for the Alliance to to support our 700+ IWs and to launch new missions initiatives.

#2 - You may give to **A Worker You Love** – this giving is applied directly to the IW that you've identified. It provides a portion of their compensation and allows the IW to direct your funds toward strategic needs or ministry initiatives they are doing, in order to create greater Gospel access.

#3 - You may give directly to **A Project You Love** –this supports a specific approved project that the worker you love, has created to improve Gospel access.

#4 - You may also give to **Relief & Development (CAMA Services)** – this giving helps the Alliance care for the most vulnerable in our world, as they recover from natural disasters, or it assists needy people in some of the world's most challenging places, to build a sustainable lifestyle.

PROJECT REIMAGINE UPDATE

Project Reimagine is the campaign fundraiser name for building a debt-free National Office campus in Reynoldsville, OH. The first 11,000 square feet has been fully funded at \$400/square foot. Now it's our turn to help fund the remainder of the project. So far, FAC has received \$2600 toward the campaign. In other words, 8 ½ square feet of our new National Office have FAC written on them.
